

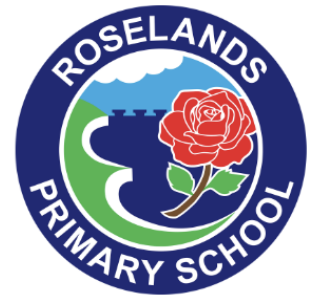
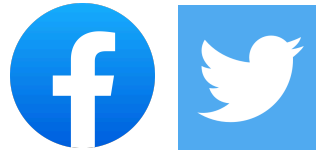

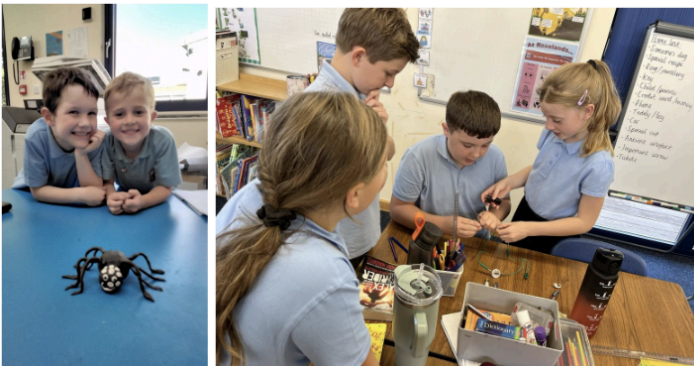


Message from Mr Brown
